NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

The name of the Trust shall be 'ARYAN EDUCATIONA' AND SOCIAL ENHANCEMENT TRUST'.

The Office of the Trust shall be at ARARIA. L.N. 176/81

3. The objects of the Trust shall be:

- (a) To raise such an institution which can provide education based on Public School Pattern on low cost to the children particularly of this educationally backward Kosi region to cope up with the present competitive life-trend without any distinction as to community, caste, race, sex, language or religion.
- (b) To provide fees, books, equipments, freeships, and/or scholarships to deserving students.
- (c) To conduct seminars/workshops and arrange special tuition/training for students.

(d) To set up and operate hostels.


- (e) To promote and advance moral education, charity and general welfare of the people.
- (f) To strive for the health, welfare and betterment of children.

- (d) Sri Anup Kumar son of Sri Mohan Lai Kumar resident of Shastri Nagar, Ward No. 11, P.O. Araria, dist. Araria Life Member
- (e) Smt. Rani Kumari wife of Sri Anup Kumar resident of Shastri Nagar, Ward No. 11, P.O. Araria, dist. Araria – Life Member The aforesaid Trustees have signed this Deed also in acceptance of the office assigned to them.
- 6. The above named Trustees shall be Trustees for life. The Trustees can co-opt with mutual consent any other person or persons, as Trustees. The Trustees so co-opted shall hold office as Trustees for the period of two years from the date of co-option. They may be re-co-opted if the

Trustees for the time being so desire. The total number of Trustees at any time shall however not exceed Twelve. On the death of any

Trustee the remaining Trustees may if they are desire somewing.


any time shall however not exceed Twelve. On the death of any Trustee the remaining Trustees may, if they so desire, appoint a person as a Trustee in place of the deceased preferably from among the legal heirs of the deceased. The minimum number of Trustees shall be three.

- 7. All the Trustees together be called as the Board of Trustees headed by the Chairman to be elected once in every two years amongst the Trustees. The office of the Chairman shall be for a period of two years. Any question arising in the administration of the Trust shall be decided by a vote of the majority of the Trustees as are present and voting at a duly convened meeting, and the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote in case of equal votes. The Chairman may also take administrative decisions which have to be ratified in the subsequent meeting.
- The Trust hereby created is not revocable at the instance of the Author of the Trust at any time and under any circumstances.

9. The Funds and Properties of the Trust shall consist of :






Trustees in this regard shall be deemed to have been taken and ratified by all Trustees.

- 11. The Trustees may open any account or accounts with any Bank or Banks in the name of the Trust to be operated upon by the chairman with another Trustee jointly or the authorised representative of the Trust on behalf of the Trust.
- 12. The surplus fund of the Trust which have not been spent in any year shall be invested in the modes prescribed under section 13(1)(d) read with section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time.
- 13. The Trustees shall at their discretion, acquire, purchase or sell immovable properties or movable properties in the course of managing the Trust. However, any sale of immovable property shall require prior consent of at least 3/4th majority of the Trustees.
- 14. The Trustees shall not be entitled to any remuneration for administering the Trust. The Trustees may be provided out of the Trust Funds the actual expenses incurred in carrying out the activities of the Trust.

- 15. The Trustees shall ordinarily meet once in three months after clear seven days of notice, issued by Chairman or by such other person duly authorised by the Chairman in this behalf.
- 16. At all meetings of Trustees, three members will form quorum.
- 17. The Trustees shall have power to appoint such staff, assistants and employees on such remunerations as they may deem fit in the administration of the Trust.
- 18. No income of the Trust shall be applied for the personal benefit either of the Trustees or of the Authors.
- 19. In the event of dissolution or winding up of Trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees/Members of the Managing Committee/Members of the Governing Body, but the same shall be transferred to another Charitable Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust.
- 20. No amendment to the terms of this Deed shall be made without obtaining the prior written permission of the Commissioner of Income-Tax. However, the

amendments to be carried out shall not infringe the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

- 21. The objects of the Trust shall be achieved without involving any activity for profit.
- 22. The Trustees and the members of their family shall not be entitled to the benefits of the Trust.
- 23. The funds/income of the Trust shall be solely utilised for achieving the objects of the Trust and no portion of it shall be utilised for the benefit of the Trustees by way of interest, bonus, dividend, profit, etc.
- 24. The benefits of the Trust shall be open to all Indians irrespective of caste, creed or religion.

25. The accounts of the Trust shall be regularly maintained and audited by a Chartered Accountant every year. The Accounting year for the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March every year.
